There will be one winner chosen for each contest, and prizes include a copy of the final publication in which the winning submission is included, a \$50 honorarium, a one year complimentary individual membership to the Oshawa Historical Society, and mention in Historical Happenings, the Oshawa Historical Society's quarterly newsletter.
